We must institute policies to mitigate Al-driven unemployment impacts on our youth.


The median income for 20–24-year-olds is \$25,000 for women and \$27,000 for men.

Paying 18-25-year-old donors \$500 per weekly 2-hour donation earns \$25,000 per year and \$200,000 over eight years.

Detoxifying and not debilitating, donors would then have the time, health, and resources over eight years to study and/or work.

The 300-liters each donor contributes would provide 150 age-related treatments.





Opportunity distribution per donation

Donor \$500 – Blood bank \$500 – Licensed administrator per patient \$500 FOB \$1,500 to collect & administer 750-ml of yFFP®



\$4,500 for three collections delivers into each patient the study-average 2-L treatment prescribed in Stanford AD & PD, TX Medical Center PD & MS, and ongoing Golden Gift yFFP observational studies, with treatment-sustainability's of up to 2 to 4 years, of more than 650 individual yFFP prescriptions.

\$16,000 average per-month cost of PPTA sterilized plasma fractions. Quantumly inactive, ABO and sex-identifying donors is irrelevant. Costly, non-regenerative monthly-maintenance medicine.
